Nominees must:

- Be an individual member of MLA or the organizational representative of an MLA member.
- Possess a Masters degree in Library of Information Science or equivalent professional training
- Have been active in the library profession in Michigan for no less than ten years and must be working currently in a Michigan library
- Have been instrumental in providing improved library service to their institution, local community, etc.

Nominees should:

- Have shown evidence of personal and professional achievement, as well as initiative and creativity
- Contributed to, and participated in, the library profession, or related fields
- Focused attention on the professional status of librarians
- Promoted cooperation between types of libraries and their librarians
- Actively participated in local and/or institutional affairs
